

## **The AnimeCon 2019 dealer room quicksheet**

The Dealer Room in a nutshell:

- **Two tickets** are included with the **first table**; all **other tables** include only **one ticket**. Any extra tickets must be purchased separately for €57.- excluding 6% VAT.
- The dealer room contains ± 200 tables of 2.00 x 0.80m
- You will have at least 1.20m space behind your table, i.e. 4 m<sup>2</sup> per table
- Renting the 4m<sup>2</sup> floor space without a table saves €6.50 excluding 21% VAT
- Chairs are provided for free
- Electricity is only available for free if requested on time and you use less than 1KW
- Wi-Fi access is free. Fixed lines costs for a basic connection of 8 Mbps down & up is available for €499 excluding 21% VAT for the weekend or with a fixed IP-address for €599. Sharing of these lines is allowed.

Dealers in all tariff groups are required to:

- Be there for all three days of the festival
- Refrain from selling anything not allowed by their contract including bootlegs
- Remove any merchandise we identify as not allowed from the dealer room
- Refrain from selling chewing gum and fresh, cold or warm food and drinks

Reserving tables without a firm intent of actually manning them is a bad idea. If you are not sure you want to come: **do not book** or it will have consequences the next year.
